## Need to Download a Video from Facebook?

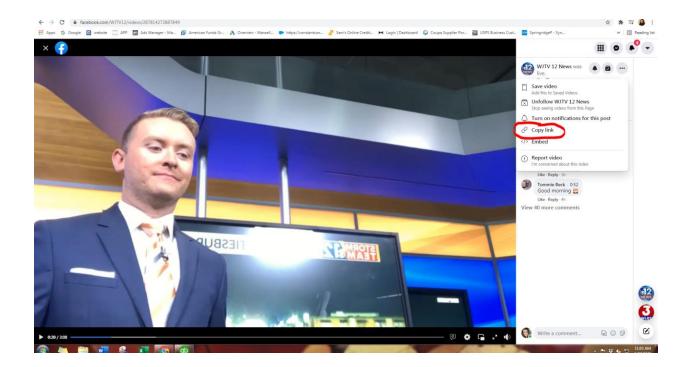
Have you ever wished you could download a video from Facebook (instead of just saving it), and could never figure out how?

## Here's a guide to help:

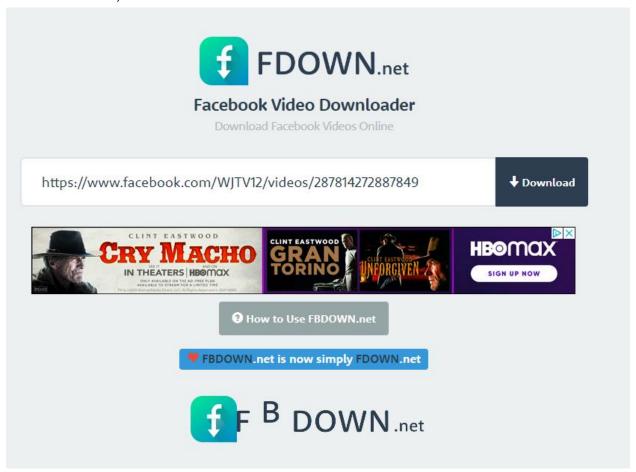
\*\*Please be aware that some videos will be complicated, depending on the settings of the page you are trying to download from.

## On a Computer:

- 1) Access the Facebook Page you want to download the video from.
- Click on the actual video, so that the link to the video itself shows in your browser.
- 3) on the right side, there's an arrow down (or 3 dots), next to the page name.
  - a. Click the 3 dots, and click "Download Video"
    - i. \*This option may not be available. Depending on the settings.
  - b. If that option isn't available, on the bottom there's the tool icon for settings, click it, and if it has "Download Video" click it.
  - If none of those options work, then go back to the down arrow or the 3
    dots, and click "Copy Link" (or just copy the link in the link bar at the top of
    the browser)



4) Once you have the link, go to <a href="https://fdown.net/">https://fdown.net/</a>. Paste the link in the bar and click download. (As long as the page/group is not closed/private, your link will download).



## On Mobile Device:

- 5) If there's a Private Group video that you want to use, down the <u>Friendly app</u> on your phone to easily download.
  - a. Once you are logged in to the app, click on the search icon on the bottom right.
  - b. Search for the page where the video is located.
  - c. Find the video you want to download and click to open it.
  - d. At the bottom of the screen you will see a purple cloud icon with an arrow down button. Click it, and then click the arrow down button on the Video Line to download to your phone.
